

Who works with or around electrical installations will be exposed to specific dangers and risks. Employees in this situation must have the authorization to perform specific work on or activities around the electrical installation or in the vicinity of it.

The employer must determine which work may be carried out by which authorized person. The AREI (General Regulations on Electrical Installations) divides these workers into two groups: BA4 warned workers and BA5 skilled workers.

A BA5 skilled person knows the dangers of electricity and reacts alertly to problems or accidents. He can independently perform work on the electrical installation to which the employer has declared him or her to be authorized.

A BA4 warned person is aware of the risks of the specific installation and the working procedures and can carry out specific actions on the internal installation only with supervision. The rule here also implies that a warned employee must be declared competent by his or her employer. The legislator states that the employer must appoint the skilled persons and warned persons and provide the necessary training.

We support the requirement imposed on the employer by providing training that can be offered in open training or customized in the company.

This training has been developed in such a way that both target groups can participate and an adapted test is provided for each target group.

Training certificate "Working safely on or around electrical installations BA4 / BA5" The employer himself grants the certificate of competence for BA4 or BA5.
